Grave dedication at Pine Forest Cemetery, Hopkins County, TX. Muster 10:00 am and service will be at 11:00 am.

Directions from Gilmer:

Take FM Road 852 to Winnsboro. Take Hwy 11 west to Pickton, approx. 8 miles then turn right on FM 269 north and go approx. 6 miles to Pine Forest. Cemetery is on the right side of the road. Turn at the Historical Marker sign and Methodist Church.

Directions from Gilmer:

Take Hwy 155 north to intersect Hwy 259 north to Hubbard, TX. Cemetery on the right. Approx. 6 miles south of DeKalb, TX

Directions from Texarkana:

Take Interstate 30 west. Exit Hwy 259 north to Hubbard, TX. Cemetery on the right.

Sat April 15 – Cemetery Memorial, Oak Ridge Cemetery, Marietta, Cass County, Texas. Muster – 10:00 am – Service 11: am

Directions from Gilmer:

Take Hwy 271 north to Pittsburg and intersect Hwy 11 east to Hughes Springs. Turn on FM 250 north approx. 15 miles to Marietta Cemetery. The cemetery will be on the left approx ¼ mile on FM 250.

Directions from Texarkana: Take Interstate 30 west and exit on Hwy 259 south and turn on Hwy 77 east approx 8-10 miles. Turn right on FM 250 south approx ¼ mile and the cemetery will be on the right of Hwy 250.
