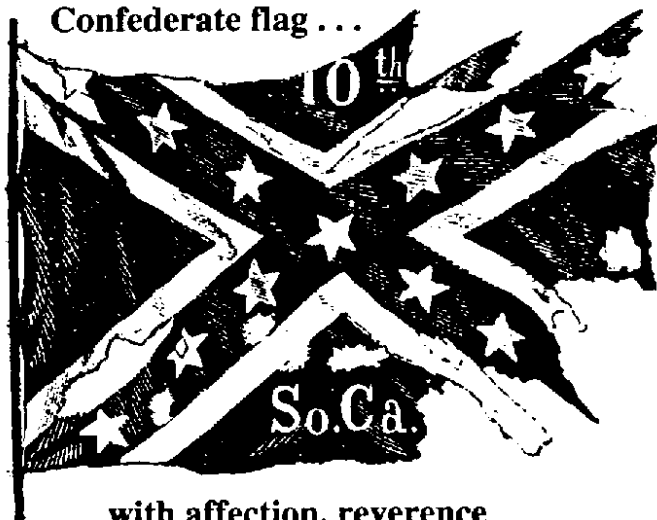
The Next Meeting Will Be November 12th
